South White Street Plan—What to Expect this Week

Construction is nearly complete on South White Street!

Currently, the railings are going up along the street in front of NC Specialty Shops, the Purple Door Day Spa, and the Wake Forest Coffee Company. Between the Town of Wake Forest and ECON, the final punch list items are currently being completed within the construction area. Some of the work for this week includes: removing old trash bins, new sign installations, cleaning yellow paint off existing curb, and finally tree installation.

Work is also nearly complete on the staging area along the sidewalk next to NC



Specialty Shops. The wider sidewalk will allow for special events and other activities. The first event is the Grand Reopening and Celebration of the South White Street Streetscape Enhancement Project on May 29th at 9 a.m. Mayor Jones, Town Staff, and Wake Forest DRC invite downtown stakeholders and residents to come celebrate the streetscape and the businesses who helped make this project a success.
